

# WESTERN AUSTRALIA FEES AND FUNDING

## Funding

Training is delivered with Western Australia and Commonwealth Government funding to eligible students.

Fees are calculated according to the level of course being studied and the number of hours undertaken, up to Government established maximums. Eligible students are able to access a government subsidised place. Fee for service is available to students who do not meet the eligibility criteria.

## Future Skills WA

**Spectra Training is approved provider under the Future Skills funding model.**

Future Skills is a WA initiative that invests in training to equip people with the skills for jobs that are in high demand in Western Australia. These government subsidised training places in the vocational training sector are for eligible students, and fees are calculated according to the level of course being studied and the number of nominal hours chosen.
